

Cable trays in the elevator machine room



Overview

Cable trays are sized with a 30–40% growth factor and routed for easy access to termination points. I maintain minimum bend radii for power and control, separate high-power from data, and leave slack for future equipment. Penetrations are sleeved and sealed. All trays and conduits are labeled, with. Each car, machine room and hoistway pit must have separate dedicated branch circuits for lighting, receptacles and HVAC, with car and machine-room lighting exempt from GFCI while required for receptacles. Overcurrent devices and disconnects must be located in machine or control spaces, be lockable. Cable trays support cable across open spans in the same manner that roadway bridges support traffic. Cable trays are a part of a planned cable management system to support, route, protect and. The Cable Tray system is installed in electrical rooms, plant rooms, and service corridors.
