

Drilling damaged fiber optic cable



Overview

This article outlines five specific steps for repair: 1) Identify the break; 2) Cut out the damaged section; 3) Strip the cable; 4) Trim the fiber ends; 5) Test the repair. DIY fiber optic cable repair kits are increasingly popular for those who prefer home repairs. Begin by identifying the damage, which can be done using an Optical Time Domain. Before diving into repairs, it's essential to grasp the basics of fiber optic cables. These cables consist of a core (glass or plastic) that carries light signals, surrounded by cladding to reflect light inward, a buffer for protection, and an outer jacket for durability.
