The basic principle behind an optical switch is to control the direction of light propagation through various mechanisms, such as mechanical movement, electro-optic effects, or thermo-optic. Co-Packaged Optics (CPO) achieves this by packaging the optical transceivers (often referred to as photonic chiplets) with the ICs on the same silicon substrate; this significantly reduces the length of the electrical path between optics and the electrical ICs, which in turn reduces power.



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The optical-to-electrical conversion that is performed by the optical transceiver is still needed in a CPO system, but it moves from a pluggable
