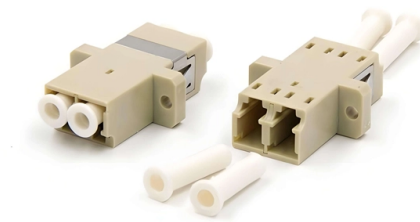


Spacing requirements for side-by-side distribution boxes

Side clearance: There should be a minimum of 30 inches of clearance from the sides of all electrical equipment, but in no case less than the width of the equipment itself. Working space around electrical enclosures or equipment must be adequate for conducting all anticipated maintenance and operations safely, including sufficient space to ensure the safety of personnel working during emergency conditions and workers rescuing injured personnel.
