

Where should the elevator cables be placed



Overview

Traveling cable is typically mounted in the elevator hoistway, where each end is terminated, and alternately takes the full load of the suspended cable as the car moves up and down. The hoistway termination may be in a mid-hoistway junction point (see Figure 1) or in the machine. Given that traction elevators operate on a counterweight and pulley system, unlike the hydraulic elevator, wire ropes (AKA cables) or flat belts are vital to their function. And these ropes must be made of the best quality steel to ensure optimal performance. It works alongside a motor and pulley system, which enables the vertical movement of. Elevator traveling cable is a vital link between the elevator car and controller. In conventional elevators, all power and signal information is transmitted through the traveling cable. The vast majority, as much as 95%, of wire and cable produced will be installed in a fixed location.
